

BreastScreen visit

Women aged 50 to 69 will be given the opportunity to have a free mammogram later this month.

BreastScreen SA's mobile unit will arrive in Cleve on October 23 and staff aim to screen up to 380 women during the two-week visit.

According to promotions and education manager Karen Shepherd over 200 appointments have already been made for the service.

Free breast cancer screening on BreastScreen SA's Mobile Unit is primarily recommended for all women aged 50 to 69 without breast symptoms.

One screening mammogram is not enough to last a lifetime - have one on the mobile unit every two years. With early detection of breast cancer, there is a greater chance of successful treatment.
